Year 4


Year 4 have been learning about the city states in **Ancient** Greece, including Athens and Sparta.

Year 5


Year 5 are currently learning about the life and career of Sir Ernest Shackleton, the inspirational polar explorer.

The children have expertly demonstrated their research skills and note taking in a variety of different ways across Reading and Writing lessons.




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




Year 6
